#### INTRODUCTION

The Company Supplied Lease and Well Management page allows you to Add and Edit Leases / Drill Permits that are in existence, but have not yet been officially created in the Texas RRC Wellbore Leases and Wells monthly data feed.

The Portal receives a monthly data refresh of Lease and Well data from the RRC. When this monthly refresh is loaded, if there are matching Leases with what you have added to your Company-Supplied Leases and Wells page, your Company-Supplied leases will be removed and replaced by the official RRC Lease, so there is not a duplicate situation in the Portal.

Edit checks are also in place to prevent a duplicate being created within the Company-Supplied or the Texas RRC data stores, while you are editing existing lease information in the grid. This checks for matching combinations of Lease Number + RRC District + Oil/Gas, if the well number is blank; if the Well Number is populated, the duplicate check with use a combination of Lease Number + RRC District + Oil/Gas + Well Number.



## WHAT'S NEW IN VERSION 3.1?

Version 3.1 contains 2 bug fixes:

- 1. When editing the Company-Supplied Leases and Wells Grid, a user could enter incorrect lengths of leases and they would save out. The rule is at least 5 digits for an OIL lease, and at least 6 for a GAS lease. (Some OIL leases are greater than 5, but nothing under 5). This check is now in place when editing row data.
- 2. **Several Lease Names and Operator Names had 2, 3, and 4+ spaces between certain separated words**. We have removed those spaces and updated lookup tables and full-text search relying on these tables for a tighter, better search.

# **PAGE FEATURES**



#### **WELL NUMBER**

Accommodation is now in place to enter the Well Number of a Lease or Drilling Permit, to give greater granularity to reporting. Well Numbers are displayed in the Ticket Management pages Grid, including the Lease-Wells Search: You may filter and search by Well Number.

#### **OPERATOR INFORMATION**

This radio button list shows the most recent Operators from the Texas RRC site. For the latest update times, see the What's New main menu navigation in the TankLogix Portal.

#### 3-PART MATCHING VS. 4-PART MATCHING

Throughout the Portal as concerning Transaction Tickets and Disposal Transactions, we deal with the 4 following key fields for matching, grouping, etc.:

- 1. Lease Number
- 2. RRC District Number (oil/well districts within Texas)
- 3. Gas-Oil Designator (O)il or (G)as
- 4. Well Number

Any of these 4 fields can be part of the monthly official Texas RRC Data stores, or they can be Company-Supplied by the user.

In this explanation of how these fields relate to each other concerning different areas of functionality in the Portal, we will look at the concatenation of the fields:

We refer to the comparison of Lease Number + RRC District + Oil Gas as 3-PART MATCHING


We refer to the comparison of Lease Number + RRC District + Oil Gas + Well Number as 4-PART MATCHING

- The Company-Supplied Lease and Well Management page allows 4-PART MATCHING on creation and edits.
- The Lease-Wells lookup in the Ticket Management 3.x page is based on 4-PART MATCHING
- The RRC Verified status in the Ticket Management Grid column header is based on 3-PART MATCHING
- The P-18 Report matching and summation are based on 3-PART MATCHING
- Future Allocation reports broken out by Well Number will rely on 4-PART MATCHING
